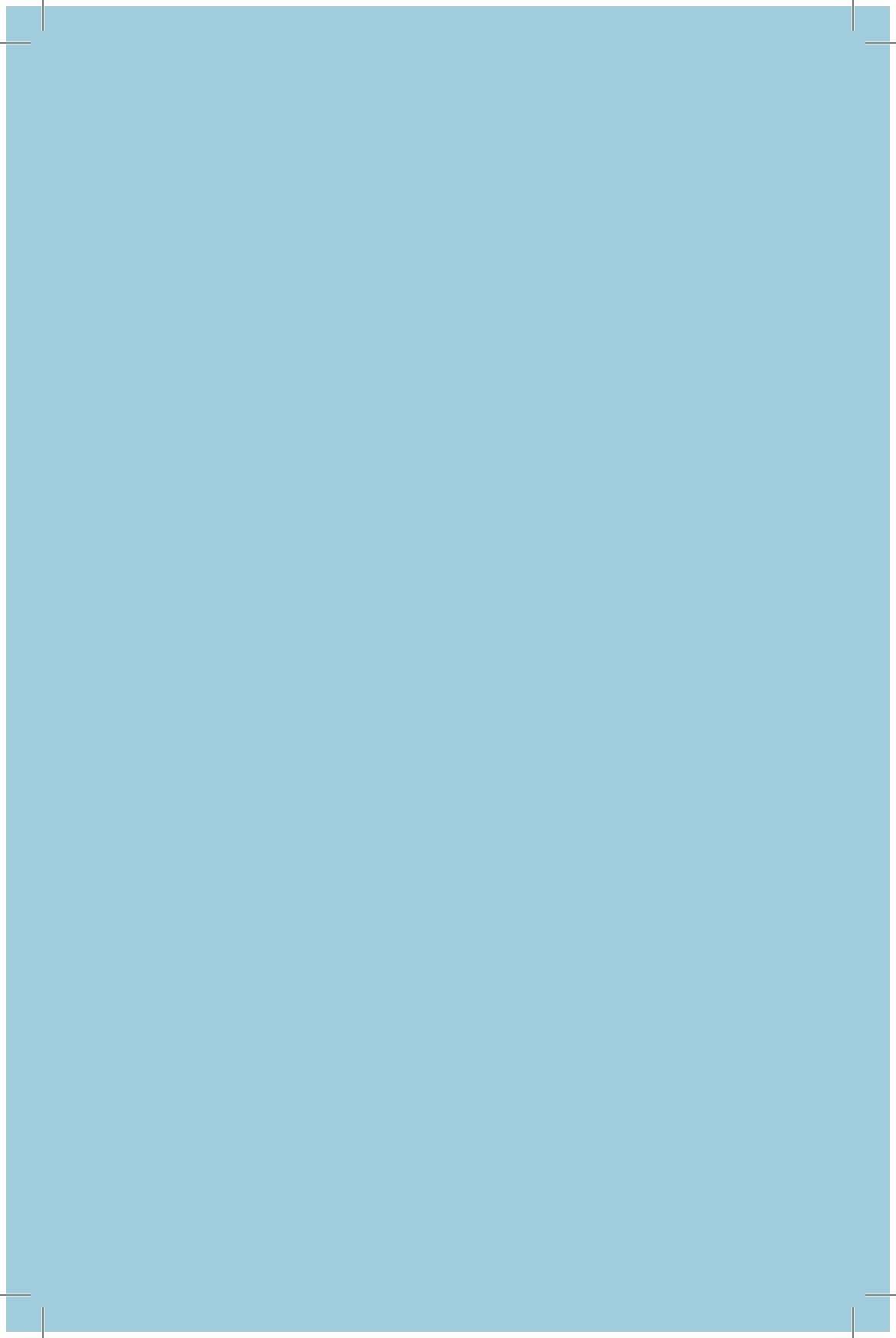

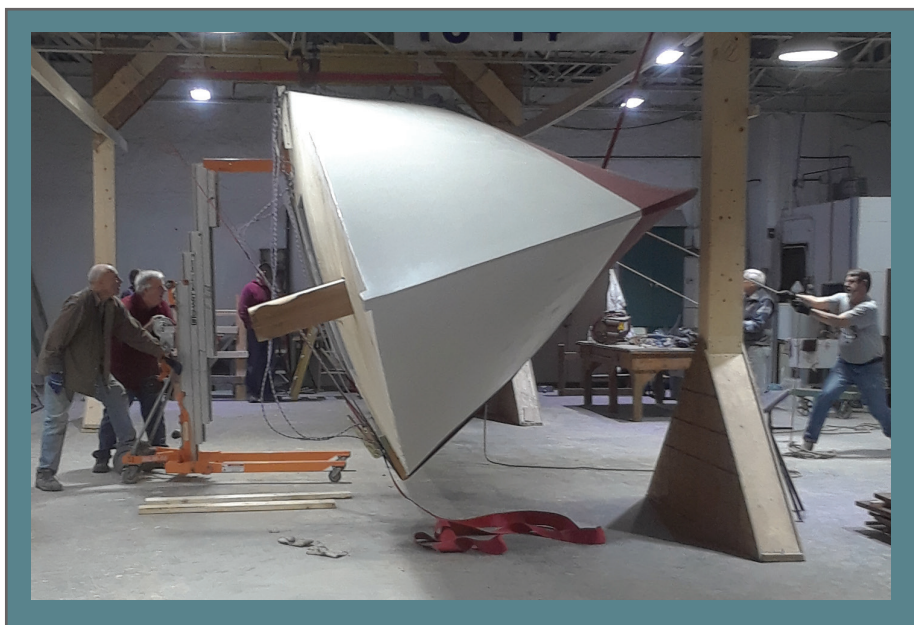
PAT II LAUNCH EVENT

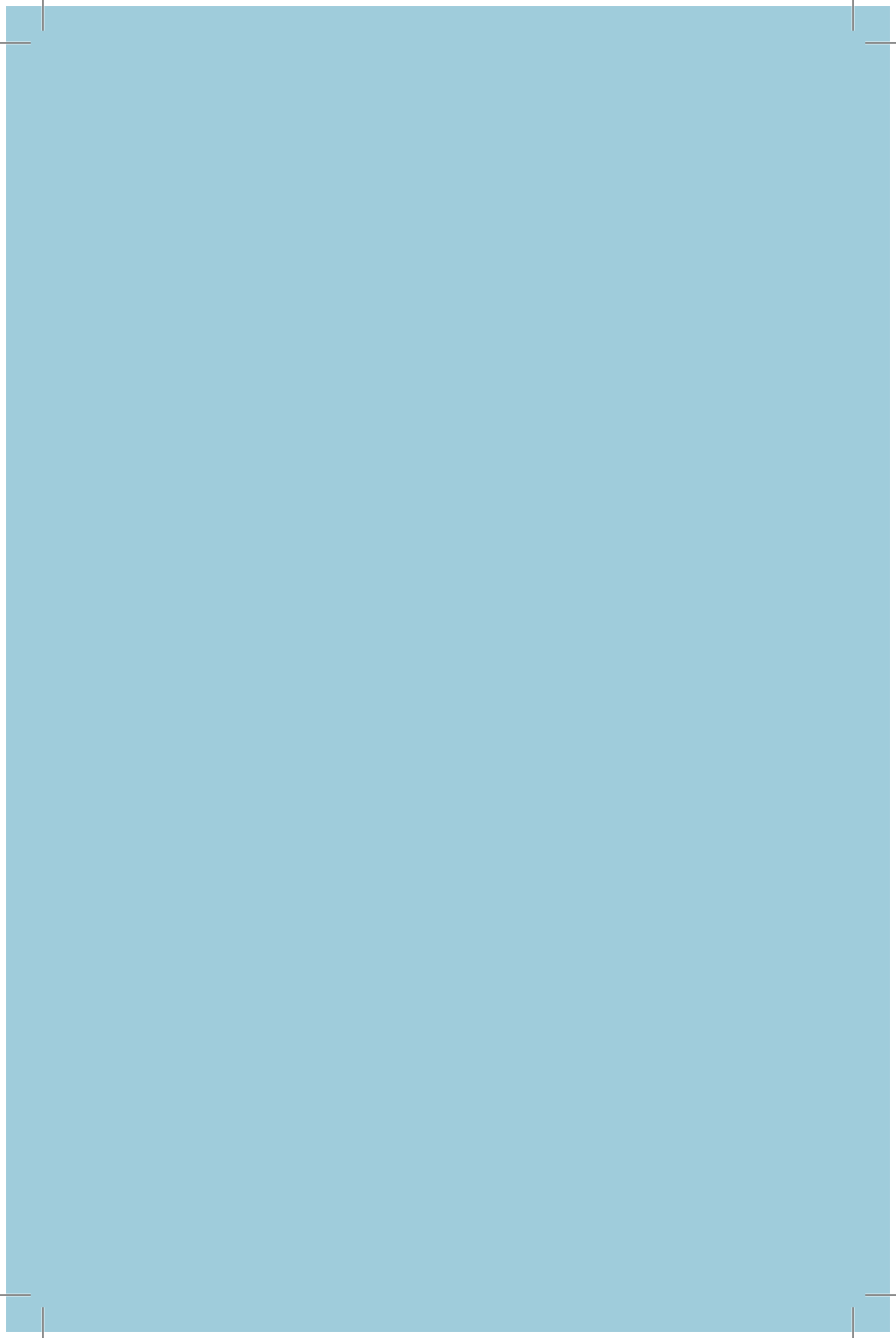
